Let's Get to Know: Ed Gonzales

I was born and grew up in San Antonio, Texas

I went to school for 12 years at St Gerard's, a small Catholic Elementary and High School taught by the School Sisters of Notre Dame. I survived that with my knuckles and sanity intact and went on to graduate from The University of Texas-Austin with a B.S. in Medical Technology and from the University of Texas School of Public Health-Houston with a M.S in Environmental Science.

My Family: I met my wife Harriet Russell at UT and in 1967 the old padre at St Austin's Church pronounced us man and wife. I've been in love with the same woman for 52 years, have lived in the same South Austin home for 47 years and driven the same Toyota for 18 years, so to say I'm resistant to change would be an understatement.
